“Take 10” and Help Hamilton Get What it Needs for the Next 10 Years

In March 2010, more than 130 million addresses will receive a 2010 Census form by mail or hand delivery. The 2010 Census will document the changes in our nation since the last decennial census in 2000, and tell us how we’ve evolved as a country.

During Census 2000, the **National** Mail Participation rate was 72%, **Illinois** was 73% and **Hancock County** was 82%. Way to go Hancock County!

March 22 through May 3, 2010, the U.S. Census Bureau will publish daily the mail participation rate data in the form of maps and tables at **2010census.gov**. The data are tabulated based on the number of forms that are mailed back. You can check to see how we are comparing this year to the National Participation Rate as it is being calculated.

Lets all work to improve our County Rate even more this year!!
